submitted in May, informs that the County's Department of Public
Works recently notified them that the resurfacing portion has been

eliminated from their work and the subsequent scope of the Draft Environmental Assessment (Draft EA) is being prepared.

States that their letter identified two components that were to be studied under the Draft EA. They are : (1) The realignment of three existing segments of Kapoho-Kalapana Beach Road, and (2) the possible resurfacing of 13.2 miles of this roadway generally situated between Kalani Honua Cultural Center and Kapoho-Kumukahi Lighthouse Road.
