The purpose of the CDP Action Committee is: <ol style="list-style-type: none">(1) Provide ongoing guidance and advocacy to advance implementation of the CDP goals, objectives, policies, and actions;(2) Broaden community awareness of the CDP and build partnerships, as appropriate, with governmental and community-based organizations to implement CDP policies and actions;(3) Take into consideration state-wide objectives and legislation for long-term and sustainable plans for the island as a whole;
Authority:	County of Hawai'i Code Chapter 16, Section 16-2
Full Membership:	9 members, North Kona and South Kona, with at least three members being from South Kona.
Specific Representation:	North Kona and South Kona Judicial District
Requirements:	The members shall serve staggered terms of four years. Upon the initial appointment of the committee, three members shall serve for a term of two years, three members for a term of three years, and three members for a term of four years.
Meetings:	Normally, one meeting per month
Financial Disclosure:	Not required.
Reappointment:	Per Mayor's discretion
Qualities:	Community-minded, team player, able to focus on the community needs as a whole without catering to special or self-interests.
