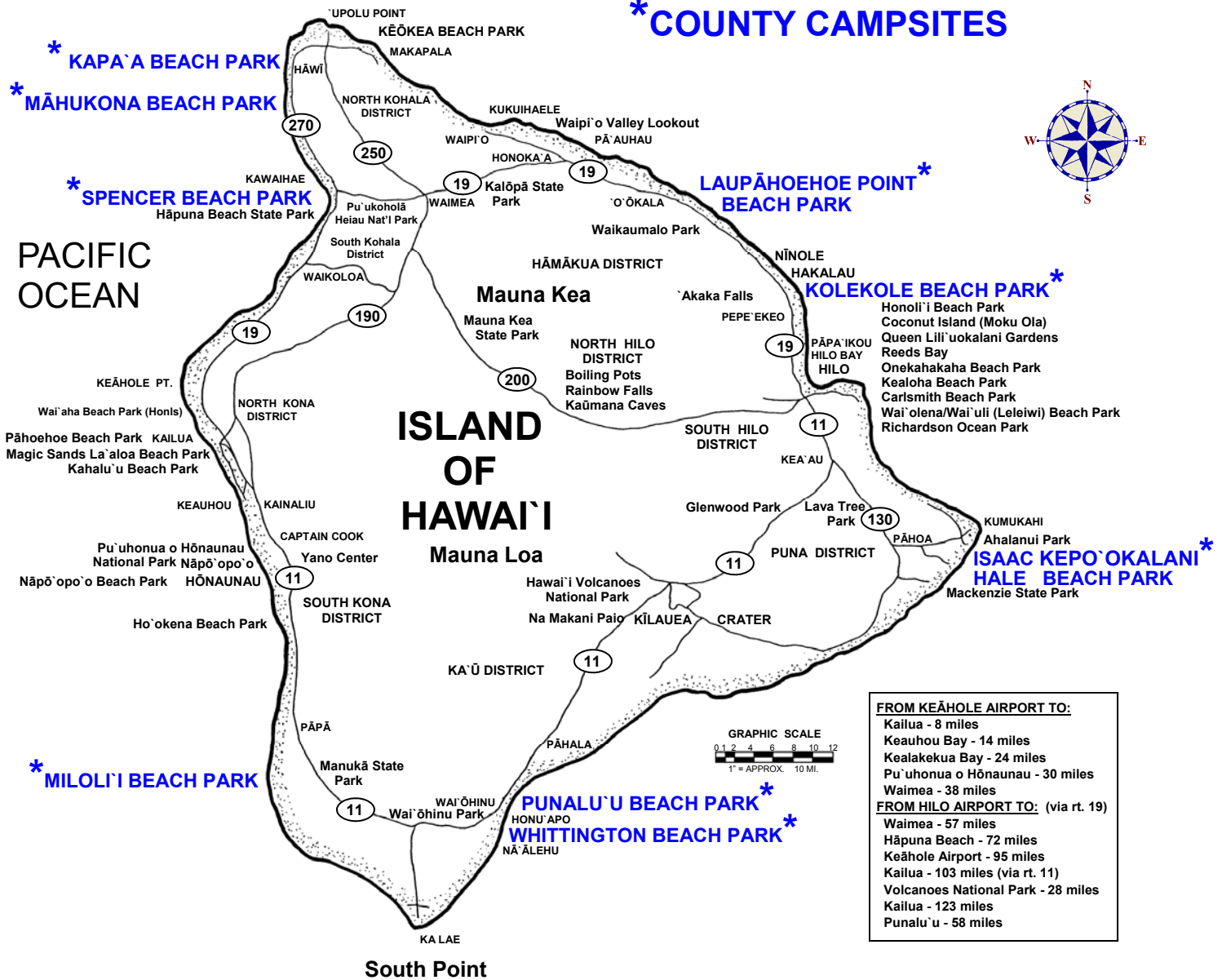

2. Camping fees
  - Adult (18 years old & over) = \$5.00 per person per night (\$6.00 Internet rate)
  - Junior (13 to 17 years old) = \$2.00 per person per night (\$2.25 Internet rate)
  - Children (12 years and under) = \$1.00 per person per night (\$1.00 Internet rate)
3. **County Code/Chapter 15/Section 15-44. Time Limits:** *No person shall be allowed to remain at any one specific camping area for a period longer than one week during the months of June through August and for a period not longer than two weeks during the other nine months of the year...*
4. PAVILION RESERVATIONS  
Picnic pavilion exclusive use fees for non-benefit group activities:
  - a. Rental Fee = \$10.00 per day or  
= \$25.00 per day with kitchen use (if applicable)
  - b. Security Deposit = \$50 per pavilion per day.  
= \$10 or \$20 Key Deposit (if applicable)
5. METHODS OF PAYMENT
  - a. Cash, money order or travelers checks.
  - b. Personal checks are accepted only if there is a two-week clearance from the reservation date.
  - c. Credit/Debit cards are not accepted at the counter.
