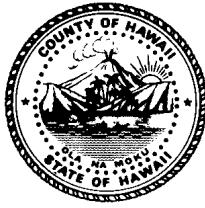

- **INVESTIGATION AND DELIBERATION OF COMPLAINTS**
 - **Complaint HPC 06-26:** Complainant alleged that officers responded to a neighbor's call and entered his residence without a warrant.
(Deferred at last meeting in order to review Chief's follow-up report.)
 - **Complaint HPC 06-33:** Complainant alleged that an officer gave her inaccurate information about obtaining a police report, the police report was incomplete and inaccurate, and the officer did not contact her on the status of the investigation.
(Deferred at last meeting in order to review Chief's follow-up report.)
 - **Complaint HPC 06-30:** Complainant was involved in a traffic stop. He alleged mistreatment by officers.
 - **Complaint HPC 06-31:** Complainant alleged that someone made a false report of a domestic disturbance at his home. He complained about the manner in which an officer handled the situation and that the Special Response Team was called to his home.
 - **Complaint HPC 07-15:** Complainant alleged that he was wrongfully stopped for speeding, the officer would not let him see the radar reading, and that the officer used profanity against him.
