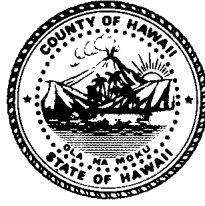

- **INVESTIGATION AND DELIBERATION OF COMPLAINTS**

- **HPC 08-08:** Complainant alleged that during an investigation of a disturbance in his neighborhood, officers went onto his property without a search warrant, invaded his privacy, violated his civil rights, and abused their police power.
- **HPC 08-12:** Complainant alleged that officers trapped him into a DUI arrest. He also alleged that he sustained scrapes, bruises, and road rash and was endangered when he was transported with criminals.
- **HPC 08-13A, B, C, D, E, F, G:** Complainant alleged that while attempting to leave a parking lot area, an officer put him in a headlock and sprayed him with pepper spray.
- **HPC 08-14:** Complainant alleged that while in her driveway looking out for traffic, an officer sped down the road and then came to a screeching stop. He gave her a citation for driving into her path and told her to shut up.
