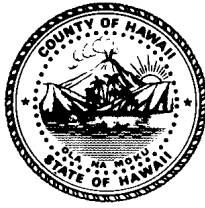

To consider discipline and charges against officers or employees of the Hawaii County Police Department where consideration of matters affecting privacy would be involved and a closed session is requested and to consult with Corporation Counsel on questions and issues pertaining to the commission's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities pursuant to HRS 92-5 (2) and Hawaii County Charter Section 13-20 (b).

 - Complaint HPC 05-33: Complainant requests an explanation for the commission's decision that there was insufficient evidence to prove the allegations.

- Complaint HPC 06-04: Reconsideration of commission's decision that there was insufficient evidence to prove the complainant's allegations.
 - Complaint HPC 06-07: Complainant was arrested for disorderly conduct. She alleged that while in jail, she was refused assistance for her incontinence, was mistreated, and humiliated.
 - Complaint HPC 06-08: Complainant complained about the manner in which she was treated during a traffic stop. She also alleged that she was not told why she was being arrested.
 - Complaint HPC 06-09: Complainant alleged that two officers did not acknowledge that he had joint custody of his daughter and that they allowed another party to take his daughter away.
 - Complaint HPC 06-10: Complainant alleged that an officer created a contrived DUI charge and arrest and subsequently lied about the incident.
 - Complaint HPC 06-11: Complainant was cited for no seatbelt. He alleged that he should not have been cited and that the officer was rude.
 - Complaint HPC 06-12: Complainant alleged that during his arrest, two officers slammed him onto his car, sprayed mace in his face, kicked him, and gave him a black eye. He also alleged that one officer withdrew his firearm and cocked it as he passed.
- **Correspondence 06-24.1, 06-24.2, and 06-24.3 from Corporation Counsel Ashida regarding improvements to the investigatory process involving complaints against the Police Department and police officers. (These are privileged and confidential attorney-client communications.) – Deferred at last meeting.**
